Basic Camp Rules

All Children and Youth Camps Basic Rules

1. No fireworks, fire igniting instruments (i.e. matches, lighters, etc.), weapons (i.e. knives, guns, etc.), tobacco, drugs, or alcohol. Violators will be sent home.
2. No TVs, radios, tape players, CD/DVD players, or cell phones.
3. Regulations require mattresses to be covered with a sheet, even if a sleeping bag is used.
4. No one other than registered campers, counselors, and camp personnel are allowed on the camp grounds at any time with out special permission from the camp director.
5. Repair of any property damage will be the financial responsibility of the party(ies) responsible for causing the damage. Any lost or stolen articles are not the responsibility of HGCRC or the SWO District - Please mark all items with campers name.
6. Immoral conduct, vulgarity, profanity or disrespectful attitudes or behavior will not be allowed.
7. Dress code for boys and girls calls for modesty. Spaghetti straps, halters, sun suits, and short shorts must be left at home. Shorts should be at least mid thigh length. All swimming suits should be one piece and modest in style, no speedo styles, bikinis, or other swim wear deemed immodest by the camp director will be permitted to be worn at camp.
8. Campers must abide by the posted curfew hours to help keep down the possibilities of a student being seriously hurt, damage to the campground property, students missing opportunities in services and unsupervised male/female meetings. Violators are subject to dismissal.
